Types and Causes of Insomnia in MS



Initial Insomnia

- -Inability or difficulty falling asleep
- -May be caused by neuropathic or musculoskeletal pain, as well as certain medications



Middle Insomnia

- -Waking during the night and being unable to fall back asleep
- -May be caused by daytime fatigue, muscles spasms, and nocturia

Terminal Insomnia

- -Waking up too early
- -May be caused by lack of exposure to daylight

Types of INSOMNIA



There are 3 types of Insomnia:



Acute insomnia

or short-term insomnia. It is brief and occurs because of life circumstances. Acute insomnia can go be treated without invasive



Chronic insomnia

happens at least three times per week and lasts at least three months. There are a number of at-home and professional treatment available for chronic insomnia, it may involve medication or special therapies to address the condition.



Transient insomnia

is short-term, lasting up to three nights. Transient insomnia is temporary and sleep will return to the normal state on its own.

• Travel or work schedule. Your circadian rhythms act as an internal clock, guiding such things as your sleep-wake cycle, metabolism and body temperature. Disrupting your body's circadian rhythms can lead to insomnia. Causes include jet lag from traveling across multiple time zones, working a late or early shift, or frequently changing shifts.

Here remedy like CORTISONE – which acts at Cortisol hormone cycle – based on Circadian rhythms

 Poor sleep habits. Poor sleep habits include an irregular bedtime schedule, naps, stimulating activities before bed, an uncomfortable sleep environment, and using your bed for work, eating or watching TV. Computers, TVs, video games, smartphones or other screens just before bed can interfere with your sleep cycle.

Here remedies like NUX VOM can be thought of

• **Eating too much late in the evening.** Having a light snack before bedtime is OK, but eating too much may cause you to feel physically uncomfortable while lying down. Many people also experience heartburn, a backflow of acid and food from the stomach into the esophagus after eating, which may keep you awake.

Chronic insomnia

may also be associated with medical conditions or the use of certain drugs. Treating the medical condition may help improve sleep, but the insomnia may persist after the medical condition improves.

Additional common causes of insomnia include:

 Mental health disorders. Anxiety disorders, such as post-traumatic stress disorder, may disrupt your sleep. Awakening too early can be a sign of depression. Insomnia often occurs with other mental health disorders as well. Medications. Many prescription drugs can interfere with sleep, such as certain antidepressants and medications for asthma or blood pressure. Many over-the-counter medications — such as some pain medications, allergy and cold medications, and weight-loss products — contain caffeine and other stimulants that can disrupt sleep.

Medications that can cause insomnia include:

- •Selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (antidepressants such as Prozac® and Zoloft®)
- Dopamine agonists (includes some medications for Parkinson's disease)
- Psychostimulants and amphetamines.
 - Anticonvulsants.
 - Cold medicines and decongestants.
 - Steroids.
 - Beta agonists.
 - Theophylline.

 Medical conditions. Examples of conditions linked with insomnia include chronic pain, cancer, diabetes, heart disease, asthma, gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD), overactive thyroid, Parkinson's disease and Alzheimer's disease.

Joint pain – sleeplessness- kali iod , kalmia

• Sleep-related disorders. Sleep apnea causes you to stop breathing periodically throughout the night, interrupting your sleep. Restless legs syndrome causes unpleasant sensations in your legs and an almost irresistible desire to move them, which may prevent you from falling asleep.

Sleep apnea – Grindelia

• Caffeine, nicotine and alcohol. Coffee, tea, cola and other caffeinated drinks are stimulants. Drinking them in the late afternoon or evening can keep you from falling asleep at night. Nicotine in tobacco products is another stimulant that can interfere with sleep. Alcohol may help you fall asleep, but it prevents deeper stages of sleep and often causes awakening in the middle of the night.

NREM Stage 1

- transition period between wakefulness and sleep
- lasts around 5 to 10 minutes





NREM Stage 3

- muscles relax
- blood pressure and breathing rate drop
- deepest sleep occurs



NREM Stage 2

- body temperature drops and heart rate begins to slow
- brain begins to produce sleep spindles
- lasts approximately 20 minutes

- brain becomes more active
- body becomes relaxed and immobilized
- dreams occur
- · eves move rapidly

SYPHILINUM

Syphilis Nosode

- The genius of *Syphilinum* often is syphilitic taint with *lot of weakness, pain with very few symptoms.*
- Syphilinum is not a remedy one will often prescribe from local indications but more of a remedy that one can prescribe after taking an overview of the case.

- Syphilinum can be very useful in ophthalmic pathologies especially chronic ophthalmic pathologies with very few symptoms. Syphilinum is often very useful in stopping the progress especially in progressive atrophy of optic nerve, also, in premature macular degeneration and in retinitis pigmentosa in children cases. Especially in ophthalmic cases where cool bathing amel with a lot of photophobia and lachrymation.
- One has to differentiate Argentum nitricum, Conium and kali bichromicum in ophthalmic pathologies.

- Syphilinum is a used also in neurological cases with very few symptoms especially with paralysis of one side with difficulty in speech, twitching of muscles. Aphasia with paralysis.
- This remedy is especially useful in slowly advancing hemiplegia.

•It also has a specific action on the musculo-skeletal system especially in spinal pathologies where there is especially pain in the coccyx on sitting for a long time. There is a lot of bone pains in this remedy. In worst form of sciatica aggravated at night.

• Typically, the *Syphilinum* constitution has almost no expressions on the face. It has a darker *Sepia* like saddle, the teeth are decayed at the edges of the gum. There is a deep longitudinal crack along the center of the tongue, the nails are distorted. They generally feel better by applied heat

- Syphilinum is one of the top remedies for the worst form of fissures in anus with obstinate constipation the patient has to take enema frequently [compare Lac defloratum and Tarentula].
- There is total sleeplessness in *Syphilinum* without any cause, total loss of appetite for months. Most of the symptoms are without any cause.

- •It's a very important remedy for ovarian diseases especially the ovarian pain where slightest touch aggravates, sensitivity to touch [Medorrhinum feels better by pressure in the ovarian pains].
- It has a peculiar offensive leucorrhoea, which is often concomitant to the ovarian pain with itching in the genitals.

- Syphilinum could be a very important remedy for many collagen vascular disorder diseases like Wegner's granulomatosis, etc.
- The sinuses are often painful with green discharges. There is often a deep seated structural damage causing this.
- Most of these symptoms are aggravated lying on the right side and aggravated in humid weather.

- Syphilinum has a strong damp weather aggravation, many cases where Natrum sulph has failed, Syphilinum has helped clinically.
- Especially in cancerous pathologies in worst form of osteosarcoma with persistent bone pain or even in cases of Hodgkin's disease.
- Night aggravation and better by slow motion are two of the consistent general modalities of Syphilinum.


One of the main Rubric of *Syph* is despair, a state of no hope, or no reaction, this is often a genius of the remedy at physical and mental level.







This indifference is much deeper to the Emotional Indifference of Phos acid.







Little babies are often seen to wake up in the middle of the night and laugh and gambol in the bright light; if this continues night after night, the parents should take warming, as often such functional irritability and cerebral hyperaesthesia end in convulsions. A few doses of Cypripedium will avert the impending danger. In respect of sleeplessness it compares well with Coffee and Scutellaria.

In Coffea the insomnia is due to an over-excitement of body or mind, the result of excessive joy or agreeable surprise.

In Scutellaria the sleeplessness is due to neurasthenia. The patient wakes up suddenly with some disturbing disagreeable dream, and finds it hard to fall asleep again.

Relationship between Melatonin & sleep via Circadian rhythms

- We all have an internal biological clock that regulates our 24-hour sleep-wake cycle, also known as our circadian rhythms. Light is the primary cue that influences circadian rhythms.
- At night, when there is less light, our brain triggers the release of melatonin, a hormone that makes us sleepy. When the sun comes up in the morning, the brain tells the body that it's time to wake up.
- When your circadian rhythms are disrupted or thrown off, you may feel groggy, disoriented, and sleepy at inconvenient times. Circadian rhythms have been linked to a variety or sleeping problems and sleep disorders, as well as depression, bipolar disorder, and seasonal affective disorder (the winter blues).







- Weak and rapid pulse, dyspnea and dropsy, dependent on failure of heart-power whether from valvular affection or from anemia, appear to be the leading indications.
- Heart-failure threatened from slightest exertion.
- The drug may cause nausea when given in the tincture unless given during or immediately after a meal.
- The mental state is that of irritability, crossness, and melancholy.
- Crat. is the nearest approach to a positive heart tonic that I know of.
- It has produced some heart symptoms and has, doubtless, a homeopathic relation, but it is not a heart-poison like Digitalis, and has no cumulative action


