Uses of zinc

Zinc uses range from metal products to rubber and medicines. About three-fourths of zinc used is consumed as metal, mainly as a **coating to protect iron and steel from corrosion** (galvanized metal), as alloying metal to make bronze and brass, as zinc-based die casting alloy, and as rolled zinc.

The remaining one-fourth is consumed as zinc compounds mainly by the **rubber, chemical, paint, and agricultural industries**. Zinc is also a necessary element for **proper growth and development of humans, animals, and plants**; it is the second most common trace metal, after iron, naturally found in the human body.

Zincum metallicum [Zinc.]

Zinc. - - The Element.

Persons suffering from cerebral and nervous exhaustion; **defective vitality**; brain or nerve power wanting; too weak to develop exanthemata or menstrual function, to expectorate, to urinate; to comprehend, to memorize.

Incessant and violent fidgety feeling in feet or lower extremities; must move them constantly.

Always feels better every way as soon as the menses begin to flow; it relieves to all her sufferings; but they return again soon after the flow ceases.

In the cerebral affections: in impending paralysis of brain; where the vis medicatrix nature is too weak to develop exanthemata (Cup., Sulph., Tub.): symptoms of effusion into ventricles.

Child repeats everything said to it.

Child cries out during sleep; whole body jerks during sleep; wakes frightened, starts, rolls the head from side to side; face alternately pale and red.

Convulsions: during dentition, **with pale face, no heat**, except perhaps in occiput, no increase in temperature (rev. of Bell.); rolling the eyes; gnashing the teeth.

Automatic of motion of hands and head, or one hand and head (Apoc., Bry., Hell.).

Chorea: from suppressed eruption; from fright.

Pressure to achieve at intellectual faculties, with Emotions being suppressed

Repeating knowledge: intelligent

Intellectual performance is very important to them. They feel driven to do very well at school. This pressure to achieve may initially lead to outstanding performances, but it can also lead to the opposite: a mental dullness. Their constant urge to acquire more knowledge can give rise to feelings of not having done enough. Then they get blocked and can't think anymore, feeling they are the 'thickest' of the class.

This situation is often brought about by an upbringing where the emphasis is on intellectual achievements. They have to get high marks at school, otherwise they won't count. Usually it is the father who exerts the most pressure, and it is typical how it is often the father who brings his Zincum child to see the homoeopath. The rational side may start to block out their feelings, making them appear flat, emotionless, even cold.



Overdoing your work: restless

They like to do their work well, but they tend to overdo it. They are extremely restless, simply can't stop and when they have nothing to do their body just carries on regardless. When they go to sleep their legs are still on the move, when they are talking their mouth makes all sort of extra movements. They have many tics, restless hands and feet. They have been brought up with the idea that 'it is no good sitting still', 'go and find something useful to do' etc. Their complaints are usually worse at times when they are forced to take a break, like weekends, holidays, but also at the end of a working day and in the evening at bedtime.

Overdoing their workthere body remains at the state of restless anxiety --- this restlessness - later on develops Neurological AFFECTIONS which are agg when they take the BREAK

The reaction time is slow, slow of grasping what is said, slow in answering, and they are much more docile, less unstable

The Zinc. child will come for treatment at about the same age, possibly a little older, and will present a history of delayed development. Delayed puberty very often gives the indication for the Zinc. child.

Holding on to your work: serious

These are serious people who work hard. They want to get on with their work, to carry on and expand. They are not allowed to ease up, whatever has been built up should be maintained. They are serious, hard working, responsible, sometimes even extremely ambitious or fanatical.



Maintaining control: cramp

They don't want to lose control and this tendency to hold on can cause cramps, either on the emotional or on the physical level. They have to be kind and keep their emotions under control, but it is rather a forced sort of smile. They won't let go of their own ideas and thoughts, which are often very conservative. They are rigid and precise. The physical signs of this rigidity are usually symptoms of cramp, often cramp in the calves, as if they are always having to stand on tip toes. But they can also be cramps anywhere else in the body; in the thighs, back, stomach, heart etc.



Maintaining order: telling tales

Rules are there to be obeyed. As long as they follow the rules nothing can go wrong. Or if something does go wrong they won't be blamed, because they have always obeyed the rules. They love rules, it gives them a sense of security. And it is very important to them that nobody steps out of line. If someone doesn't follow the rules they will report them. These are the children who tell tales.



Detaining people who make mistakes: guard

Their desire to control can be quite obsessive. Everything has to be checked, everything has to be perfect. They consider it their task to maintain order and can get very angry if other people step out of line.



Maintaining order: ritual

Another way of maintaining order is through ritual. **Ritual** is a key word for Cuprum. Their rigid desire to follow the rules can lead to ritualistic behaviour, a seemingly meaningless set of actions that are constantly repeated in the same order. This remedy could be very useful for people who are frequently involved in rituals, people such as priests or judges. There is often also a sort of superstitious element in these rituals, 'touch wood', 'cross your fingers' etc.

Compare with niccolum

Niccolum lies in the same group with Platinum and Palladium, and shares with these two the qualities of egotism and superiority. When the two factors of attack and defense are combined with superiority, there emerges the feeling that he is superior to others and must come to their rescue and defense. I have seen in the proving and in Niccolum patients, the strong need to fight for others and to protect others from wrong, from antisocial elements, to fight like the policeman or defender of the community. The sense of duty and ego are both exhibited in Niccolum. They are disposed to contradict, but are themselves intolerant of contradiction. They are anti-authority, self-confident people and have a certain hardness about them.
